- Appomattox Court House, VA

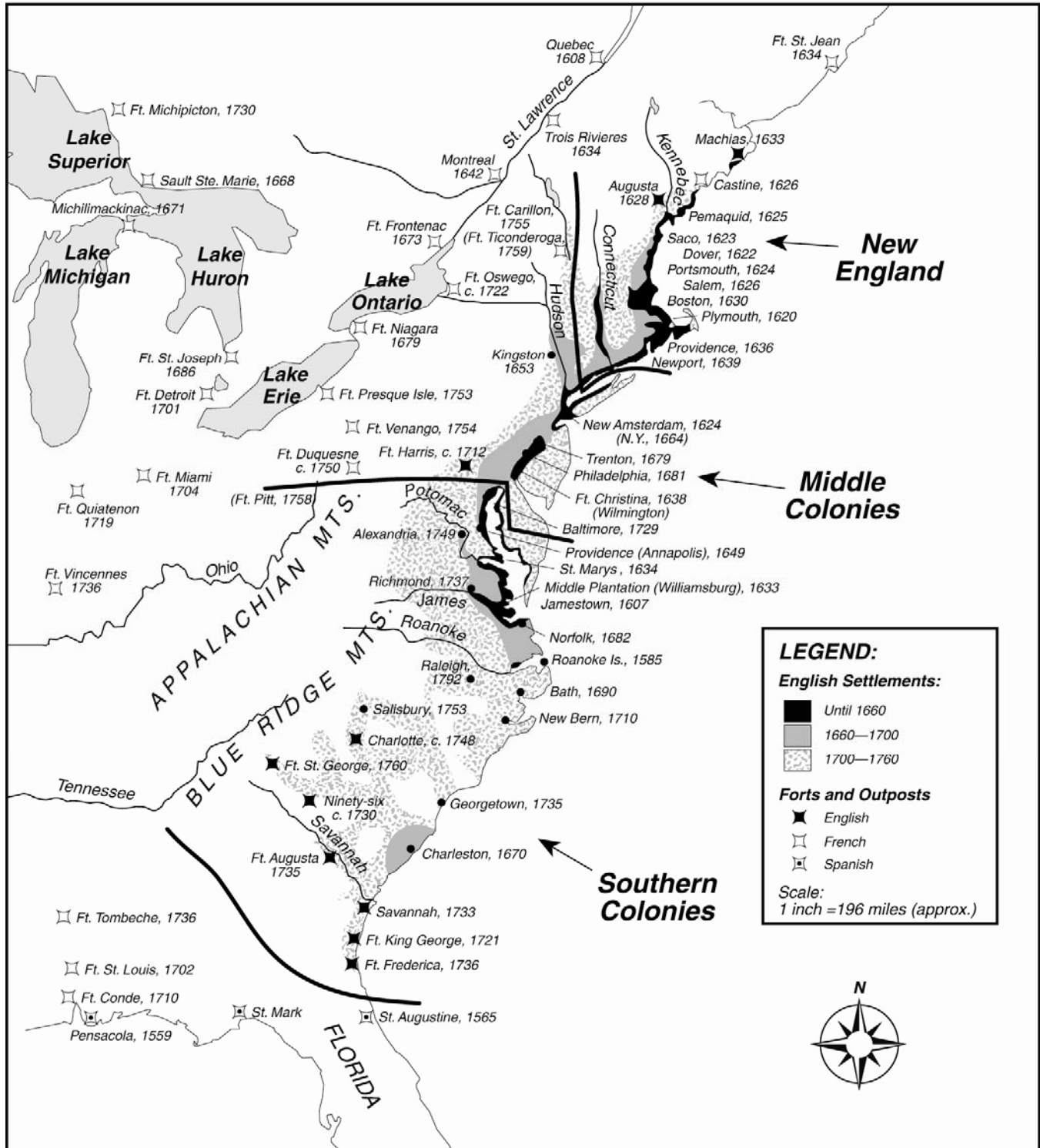
Now think back to (and perhaps re-read) the instructions to Jamestown's settlers.
